

Considerations	Guidance	EPC Procedures
<b>Entering &amp; Leaving School Premises</b>	Maintain 2m distance where possible and check with Office staff as to the process for signing in	<p>Staff will clean hands-on arrival, before/after eating, after sneezing or coughing.</p> <p>Passing in a corridor is considered very low risk, however, EPC staff will consider the route necessary to reach their destination and will also follow the schools one way system.</p> <p>EPC staff will not use communal staff rooms during visits to the school at this time.</p>
<b>Equipment Safety</b>	Sharing of equipment should be kept to a minimum	<p>If equipment is required to be shared then this will be kept to a minimum, where possible equipment will remain one per each participant</p> <p>All equipment used WILL be cleaned thoroughly after each session before it is ready to be used by another group using the anti-bacterial cleaning spray provided by EPC</p> <p>Children will be advised to share equipment via their feet opposed to their hands where possible – staff will give strict instructions to this effect</p>
<b>Session Procedures</b>	<p>Wearing a face covering or mask in schools is not recommended</p> <p>Contact sports</p> <p>Use hand sanitiser and ensure that proper hand washing occurs before and after PE sessions</p>	<p>EPC coaches are not required to wear a face mask or covering during school sessions that take place outside.</p> <p>Should lessons need to take place indoors then good ventilation is encouraged through ensuring doors &amp; windows remain OPEN during sessions. EPC staff to wear a face covering or visor for these lessons where they feel appropriate (the size of indoor space available will impact this, is always social distancing still possible?)</p> <p>EPC staff will use a combination of individual based and contact activities throughout the lessons, allowing a contact mix for children within the same ‘bubble’ only</p> <p>Staff will use hand sanitiser (provided by EPC) and rigorously clean hands before and after each lesson and after touching any equipment. Pupils must wash their hands before and after each lesson in line with school hygiene policy</p>

	<p>Water Bottles &amp; Toilet Breaks</p> <p>Session arrival &amp; dismissal procedure</p>	<p>All pupils must have their own labelled water bottle which they must have with them during the session and toilet breaks must be taken on an individual basis.</p> <p>2m social distancing will be active from the outset with staff setting out distancing for both the arrival and dismissal procedures</p>
<b>First Aid</b>	<p>First aid kits must be carried out and be present at all sessions</p>	<p>All first aid incidents during sessions will be dealt with by the school designated first aider.</p>
<b>Pupil Considerations</b>	<p>Considering pupils physical and mental health and wellbeing</p>	<p>EPC staff will be enthusiastic and display a positive body language</p> <p>Staff will manage the duration and intensity of activities to suit pupils needs effectively</p> <p>Staff will attempt to reconnect socially with children whilst maintaining social distancing</p> <p>Staff will reiterate the importance of good hygiene and why it is important from a personal perspective</p>
